



COVID - 19 STATEMENT

"Coronavirus"

03/08/2020.

Premier Daniel Andrews upgraded Victoria's "status" from State of Emergency to a "State of disaster" from 6pm, Sunday August 2, for a month to try to stop the spread of the "Coronavirus" (COVID-19).

Active TEC shall not be providing any "face to face" in class training sessions until such time as the Victorian Government changes the existing rules and conditions surrounding this service.

We are sorry we are unable to continue to support our students goals of obtaining certain course certificates and licenses, however we shall not providing training that requires face to face application, where the best advise given to us, is to stop this practice for time being.

As of the date on this statement the government has advised educational institutions to that only courses that can be carried out in an online mode, may continue during the restrictions.

It is important to remember that courses that have a practical content, must be completed in a setting that allows for the assessor to carry out relevant assessments.

We suggest student be wary of providers who claim they can do the training without satisfying the practical assessment component of a course.

Keep an eye on our website and the calendar for updated course dates as they become available.

Please stay safe, wash your hands and sanitise, wear masks and maintain recommended distances from others.
