



## 22325VIC - Course in Workplace Spotting for Service Assets

It is vital that people, plant and equipment is kept a "safe distances" when working in and around Overhead or Underground assets.

This course provides individuals with the opportunity to receive the knowledge and skills to guide people, plant and equipment to safe working distances and not to enter established No Go Zones. To work as a "No Go Zone" spotter you must complete this unit of competency and establish a basic level of competency to be registered with Energy Safe Victoria (ESV).
