CPPFES2005A - Demonstrate First Attack Fire Fighting Equipment

This course provides theoretical and practical training in the use of portable fire fighting equipment.

The participant shall be provided training to cope with minor fire emergencies that they may encounter in their workplace or at home.

In particular the focus shall be aimed at understanding and categorising fires, selecting the appropriate fire fighting equipment and understanding the capabilities of each piece of equipment to assure they are not placing themselves or other at risk.

Course Content

- Understanding the dangers associated with fire emergencies
- Carry out risk assessment and establish realistic response capability.
- Examine the Fire Triangle and the various constituents of fire.
- Categorise fire into Classes A - F
- Understand and employ the R.A.C.E procedures.
- Select the most appropriate fire extinguisher.
- Understand and Utilise the P.A.S.S sequence.
- Utilise Hose Reel and understand the extent of their application.
- Utilise Fire Blankets to its best advantage and application.
- Understand maintenance and service requirements under specific Australian Standards.
