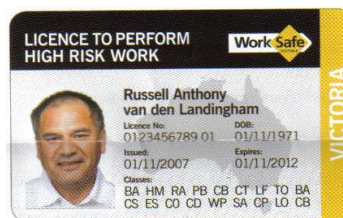
Active T.E.C provides two (2) courses, the first to assist those interested in obtaining a license to Perform High Risk Work (LHRW) to legally operate a Boomlift.

The second is designed to assist with those who have a licence, and need to complete Verification of Competency (V.O.C) training and assessment, designed to update and validate the performance of a person who holds an existing Boomlift > 11 metres licence.

Our courses are designed to provide participants with sufficient practical and theoretical training, prior to conducting assessments to verify the participant is "competent" to operate a Boomlift, and / or eligible to obtain a license.

There are two (2) levels of Boomlift training and assessment offered, to cater for varying degrees of practical experience a participant may possess.

This give our students the ability to select the training level and process that best suits their needs!



1. License to Operate a Boomlift > 11 Metres.

Course Code: TLILIC0005

Objective - To provide our students with the theoretical and practical skill sets to operate a Boomlift safely, and complete relevant assessments successfully so they may obtain a licence for high risk work.

Course Duration: 2 days (16 Nominal Hours)

Course and Assessment Cost: \$440.00

Planned Process for Licensing Courses :

Once a person makes a booking and the course fee is provided, study materials are provided to the participant, to allow them ample time to read and assimilate the information, strengthening the ability of the participant to complete the theoretical assessment component successfully.

The students knowledge is then further enhanced via the "in class" training conducted in the training sessions, additional time is also allocated to the practical operation of the Boom Lift when they attend the training session.

Students are best advised to book at least 7 days in advance of a course date commencing, to ensure they have ample time to study the course materials provide to them for the training course and assessments.

Course Elements (Summarised)

1. Plan work tasks considering workplace hazards, equipment capabilities and required communication processes.
2. Prepare for Boom Lift operations, review and inspect Boomlift and assure capacity, capabilities and condition via pre - inspections are validated.
3. Perform tasks using Boom Lift to elevate the boom to various height, and maintain safe operations.
4. Pack up work area and shut down and inspect Boomlift, utilising recognised procedures.



Prerequisites /

Recommendations: Students must be a minimum of 18 years of age, photo identification must be provided at course registration.
Students must be able to communicate, read and write "English" and may not have an interpreter present, to assist them in the assessments (Work Safe Requirement).

2. V.O.C Training and Assessment

Course Duration: 1 days (6 - 8 Nominal Hours)

Course and Assessment Cost: \$240.00

1. A pre- assessment of both theoretical knowledge and practical ability is conducted at this session, followed by a training session which is tailored to target to "gaps" identified.
2. The individual completes a final assessment and pre and post assessment performances are reviewed.
3. A results report is generated to reflect the overall program.
